

# School Library Awards

School librarians and teachers play an important role in the education and mentoring of student writers. The resources available in the school library are also valuable tools for students who are exploring the world of reading and creative writing.

In honor of librarians, teachers, and student writers, *Pine Tree Poetry* supports school libraries in two ways:

1. Every school that submits student poems to *the Pine Tree Poetry Collection* will receive a **free copy** of the book for the school library.
2. The top twenty-five schools that submit the most poems for consideration will receive a **\$300 check** from Pine Tree Poetry that may be used for library materials. **PLUS** fifty more schools will be awarded **\$50 checks**.

## Details:

In order for your school library to receive a free copy of the *Pine Tree Poetry Collection*, you'll need to send in a completed School Submission Form along with the poetry submissions from your school. The form is available on our web site. We'll send one free book per school.

Twenty-five schools will receive a \$300 check for school library materials. Since this award is based upon the largest number of poems submitted for consideration, having many students participate is important. However, each student may only submit one poem. Before sending in your poems, please check for duplicate students and be sure to include the School Submission Form.

In order to allow smaller schools an opportunity to receive an award, we will also be awarding \$50 checks to fifty more schools. These schools will be chosen by random selection from among all schools that submit at least ten poems for consideration.
